# Course Concept

- A hands-on, India-first global mastertrack that turns ESG/CSR/climate rules into assurance-ready operations. Learners build real artefacts—CSR policy packs, BRSR/Core evidence registers, EPR calendars, EU CSRD/Taxonomy datapacks, California SB 253/261 scoping, AU/NZ disclosures, GCC issuer maps—culminating in a Board-ready, multi-jurisdiction compliance plan.



# Audience

- Primary: CSOs/ESG Heads, Finance Controllers, Legal/Compliance, Internal Audit, Investor Relations.
- Secondary: Procurement/Supply-chain (Scope 3, EPR, CBAM), HR/CSR managers, Sustainability consultants, Board secretariat.
- Ideal org profile: India-HQ or India-exposed firms with EU/US/UK/GCC/AU/NZ/SEA/Africa touchpoints (listings, customers, suppliers, or facilities).



# Learning Outcomes

- Design a compliant CSR program under the Companies Act (Sec. 135) with policy, governance, spend/impact, and disclosures
- Produce a BRSR & BRSR-Core evidence register with internal controls suitable for limited assurance.
- Stand-up EPR workflows (e-waste, plastics) and vendor documentation
- Build a jurisdiction map and disclosure datapack for EU CSRD/ESRS + Taxonomy + CBAM.
- Scope and plan US/California SB 253 & 261 compliance and assurance pathways.
- Prepare UK, AU/NZ, GCC, SEA, and Africa issuer-level disclosure maps aligned to ISSB (IFRS S1/S2).
- Operate a quarterly governance cadence (risk & controls register, evidence upkeep, supplier engagement).
- Deliver a Board-ready Compliance Plan (slides + memo) with budget, milestones, KPIs, and risk mitigations



# Program Objectives

- Ship 12+ reusable toolkits (CSR policy, BRSR-Core register, EPR calendar, ESRS datapoints, SB253/261, Taxonomy/CBAM, GCC/AU-NZ packs) by Week 12.


