


BEING PERFECT

Define Aamir Khan's personal style?

His personal style statement is eclectic, easy and comfortable, yet very distinguished. He likes trying new silhouettes and loves brainstorming with us on new looks in interesting fabrics.

How experimental is Aamir?


Aamir loves and lives the character he portrays. He knows no bounds when he wants to achieve the perfect mood for the role he's playing. So once we suggest a look, he will go the whole hog to experiment and adapt completely.

What clothing do you think looks the best on him?

We love him in a fusion of Western and Indian ensemble, which he doesn't sport so often. In *Satyamev Jayate*, we have styled him in a linen silk, ashes-of-roses mandarin collar shirt with suede, knit quilted waistcoat thrown over it.

Which colours and fabrics suit him the best?

Aamir looks fabulous in jewel tones, darks and moody mid-tones. And natural fabrics like cashmere silks, pashminas, crushed *malmal* and bamboo knits love him, draping beautifully on him. Though he can pull anything off because of his complexion and the way his eyes take the mood and hues of his look.

In which film do you think could he have looked better?

We are obviously extremely judgmental of our own work and believe there is always scope for improvement. And our constant lament on feature films is, 'Wish we had 10 more prep days!' And, 'Wish the director agrees to all our mad-hat ideas,' so yes, we love him in the looks designed by us and at the same time, we constantly critique our work.

Do you think he has been an inspiration in terms of fashion?

Yes, he is a designer's dream because he brings to fruition any new brainwave that fashion can throw at him. And he's our muse.
